

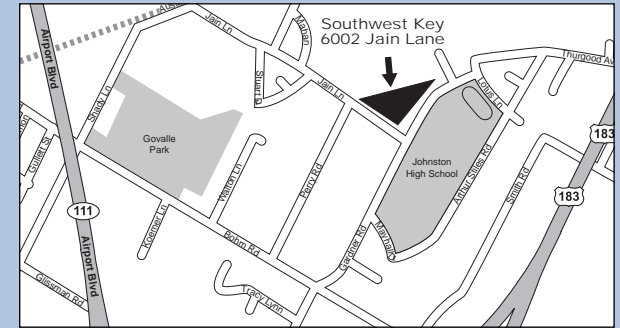
**Get paid to write your own play,

WHO: Youth and young adults between the ages of 14 and 17 (or up to 21 if still in school). All who are interested must:

- Be enrolled and attending school in the City of Austin and/or Travis County
- Reside within the City of Austin and/or Travis County
- Must have a valid social security card
- Must have a current year school identification or report card
- Must complete the job readiness training

WHEN: June 8th through July 10th, with a special presentation on Sunday August 2nd on the Paramount Stage.

WHERE: Paramount Theater and Southwest Key's East Side Community Center

HOW DO YOU GET INVOLVED: There will be a training session scheduled at Southwest Key where you will come with a legal guardian to register with the city based work program.

PLEASE NOTE: Even if you don't get matched with the Youth Theatre Program, the city will still find a job for you at a non-profit in Austin if you are interested
